Caitlyn's deep love for school, a passion for learning and determination for self advancement has been the inspiration behind the establishment of this scholarship in her memory.

Caitlyn's F.I.G.H.T. Scholarship will be awarded to a Putnam Valley High School Senior who has exemplified the true meaning of F.I.G.H.T. (see brochure) and has demonstrated a character in the likeness of Caitlyn by overcoming an adversity in their life; one who has inspired and/or given great hope to others or has made helping others an integral part of their life.

The scholarship will consist of a one-time award and can be used for any accredited college or trade school related expenses. The scholarship application will be available at the Putnam Valley High School Guidance Office starting on January 24, 2012, in honor of Caitlyn's birthday, January 24, 1994. The deadline to submit the application is April 17, 2012. The Scholarship Committee will review all the applications and contact the qualified candidates for an interview. The scholarship winner(s) will be invited to attend the Putnam Valley High School Senior Awards Ceremony held in June 2012.

What is the meaning behind the F.I.G.H.T. Logo?

FIGHT - Family Inspires Great Hope Together

Webster's defines Family as: 1) a group of persons of common ancestry (clan); and 2) a group of people united by certain convictions or a common affiliation (Fellowship).

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Understanding cancer...

Cancer is the direct result of either a mutation of the cellular DNA or some sort of damage to the cellular DNA. For the cancerous cell to actually develop into a tumor, it must be able to grow and to replicate itself. If it cannot do this, it will die or lie dormant for an extended period.

What actually causes genetic mutations or DNA damage is not yet completely understood, but several significant factors that encourage cancer development have been identified.

Little did I know how important those words would become after a routine test performed on Dec 27th 2008 showed a large mass in my daughters liver. It is now the early morning hours of day 20 in the fight of my 14 year old daughters battle against advanced Fibrolamellar Hepatocellular Carcinoma (FHC with mets), an extremely rare form of liver cancer of which no protocol in terms of a cure has been established." -Blog entry by Joe Bagnato, at www.afathersperspective.com
